- Spiritual direction and informal time with priests and religious formators.





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HOW YOU PREPARE TEAM DIRECTORS TO LEAD



Benefactor support has introduced an even more meaningful way for veteran missionaries to grow in servant leadership. This year, you launched the St. Paul Team Director Fellowship Program, a more defined and deeper investment in these young men and women.

This is a three-year program for staff serving as team directors through which you provide a deeper human, spiritual and professional formation to them that can be a crucial foundation for the rest of their lives!

"I can confidently say that I have been thoroughly convicted of God's call for my life. The opportunity to hear from other first-year team directors about their anticipated challenges and fears, along with hearing from veteran staff about their experience and wisdom, was incredibly reassuring as I progress into this next stage of prayer and planning. Being the 'chief formation officer' [for my missionary team] is daunting, but I know the Lord will provide for this new mission in every last way. I can't wait for the chance to serve my teammates in a radical new way, and to see how the Lord desires to stretch me in unexpected ways."

Adam, a third-year missionary with FOCUS, is serving as the team director for Texas A&M University-Kingsville.

"In this new role, I am called to go beyond myself and be a servant to the missionaries I am leading. I am called to love my teammates unrequitedly, to sacrifice



for their good, to humble myself and seek their interests above my own. I am given the opportunity to encounter Jesus on a new and deeper level through the joys and the struggles, the frustrations and the glories, in the cross and the resurrection. Becoming a team director means that I am called to be Christ to the missionaries on my team so that they can be built up and confident to be sent out on mission, but more importantly, so that they are able to grow to become saints. One thing that was said time and again throughout training was that who we become is more important than what we do."

Maria, also a third-year missionary with FOCUS, is serving as the team director for one of FOCUS' newest campuses, the University of Delaware.
