



Dear Friends,

One night 20 years ago, as Dr. Scott Hahn and I were preparing to appear on "Mother Angelica Live," Scott said, "You should launch FOCUS."

I laughed. At the time, FOCUS existed only in my head and on a few scraps of paper. When my wife Michaelann agreed, though, we went on the air and announced the launch of the Fellowship of Catholic University Students. Little did we know what was to come of it.

Just a few months later, Edward Sri (Ted) and I hosted the first official FOCUS activity: a retreat with 20 students. Later that same week, Ted led a Bible study for some of those students who attended the retreat, who in turn led the same study for other students. That following summer, we trained four new missionaries and expanded to a second school — and the FOCUS mission took off.

Today, we look back in humility and gratitude at the way the Lord has multiplied our growth on new campuses and helped us meet new students. More than 700 missionaries currently serve 164 campuses, including several international locations. In January, we hosted nearly 17,000 people at our SEEK2019 conference. We have tens of thousands of alumni launched into lifelong Catholic mission in parishes, workplaces and communities. And in the next ten years, we expect to reach more than 800 campuses and hundreds of thousands of actively involved students.

The New Evangelization is happening now, and it's happening through FOCUS.

The impact is impressive, but the stories even more so. As you'll find in the following pages of the report, we've seen so many individual lives change through prayer, friendship and the witness to a virtuous life. Thanks be to God!

All our efforts would be impossible without God's grace and your partnership. Thank you for supporting FOCUS this past year and for helping us to bring the truth and beauty of Christ and His Church to young people.

Sharing the method of evangelization modeled to us by the Master, Jesus Christ, who invested in a few and commissioned them to do the same.




REACHING THE WORLD FOR CHRIST

FOCUS MISSIONS

Since 2004, FOCUS Missions has grown from one mission trip in Peru to 139 trips in nearly fifty countries. Today, FOCUS Missions has become one of the largest Catholic mission organizations in the world.

A FOCUS mission trip offers students, missionaries and chaplains an opportunity to encounter Christ in the poor, in the Sacraments and in authentic friendships. In partnership with local on-the-ground organizations, these mission trips take participants out of their comfort zones and allow them to separate from the noise of daily life as they bring the Gospel to those they encounter around the world. While the reach of these efforts is incredibly broad, the effect on an individual participant's heart is immeasurable.



SEEK2019

In January, nearly 17,000 people attended SEEK2019 in Indianapolis, a five-day event that encouraged everyone to encounter something more and to hear, feel and share the joy of Christ and the Gospel.

Catholic speakers presented on topics relevant to all audiences, and more than 400 priests concelebrated daily Mass. More than 8,000 confessions were heard throughout the event, with 4,700 of those heard during Adoration and Confession Night.







FOCUS, both for what it is doing for the Church and in their personal lives. "We continue to meet people and see the fruits of this ministry," said James.



Carlos and Lucy Moas first heard of FOCUS through their son, Victor. He was a freshman at the University of Florida, and when he called home, he wouldn't stop talking about the FOCUS missionary he had met, Miko Sy. Victor and Miko grew in friendship, and soon enough, Victor was leading a Bible study on campus.

"I, of course, was thrilled because he was at this huge school of 50,000—which at the time had the dubious distinction of being the number-one party school in the nation," said Lucy. "We sent him off with much trepidation, and we were so grateful that he became part of FOCUS."

The following year, their second son, Raffi, began his studies at the University of Florida. "FOCUS found him and didn't let him go either," said Lucy. "He also became a Bible study leader."

Carlos added, "I would say the effect FOCUS has had on our children and family has been incredibly inspiring. It was important that they got off to a good start, but to see them deepen in their faith was amazing." From praying the breviary with smartphones at the Catholic center to canoeing the Sewanee River with priests, the Moases witnessed a renewal of faith in their children's lives and in their own. "Seeing the Eucharistic procession at SEEK and thousands of students in adoration is an image I will never forget," said Carlos.

"You want to be a part of something that is beautiful, something that is growing and flowering," Carlos added. "It has been such a blessing for us to see what FOCUS has done for our family that we felt it was important to give back."



It was also through his father that John came to know FOCUS. "I started meeting these FOCUS missionaries, and I was so impressed with their commitment to the faith." He continued, "They were willing to share God's word and God's love with not just college students but with me."

A current resident of Boston, John began to take the local missionaries out for lunch to hear more about their work on campus. "The ongoing relationship with anyone associated with FOCUS overwhelms me at times. The holiness of these young adults is so infectious." John has been encouraged and inspired to attend daily Mass, incorporate more daily prayer, and even serve sandwiches to the homeless. "Young people are more apt to push you out of your comfort zone, which inevitably draws me closer to prayer and to holiness."

Seeking holiness in such as way is reinvigorating his family life as well as his spiritual life. "My greatest hope for our Church is that it creates saints out of all of us through love of Christ and love of neighbor." He continued, "FOCUS is needed to help sustain Christ's Church wherever we live and wherever we work."


