

11 STEPS TO **IGNATIAN CONTEMPLATION**

Review the **History**

Do a bit of research into the time period, events, customs, related Bible passages, etc., surrounding the passage to better understand the context.

Create the Composition

You can do this by imagining the place—for example, see the road from Nazareth to Jerusalem.

See the Persons

See the characters. See them visually, but also try to see them Pray from the Heart

Ask for an interior knowledge of Our Lord, that you may know him more, love him more, follow him more.

in other ways - emotionally, spiritually. Understand where they are in their lives in this passage.

Ignite the Five Senses

Seeing, hearing, smelling, tasting, touching. Places, people, faces, emotions.

Participate

Place yourself in the scene, contemplating it just as if you were there.

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Heart Check

Take some time to reflect on yourself, and where you are during this moment in your life and prayer.

Listen

Pay attention to any dialogue in the passage. Observe what they are saying.

Heart to Heart

Conclude with a conversation with Jesus or Mary, as a friend speaks to a friend, or a servant to a leader; speaking your concerns and asking for advice.

See the Action

What are the characters' actions and their meanings? Consider what they are doing and the context surrounding it.

Close with a Familiar **Prayer**

Our Father, Hail Mary, etc.

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
